Emails about this half terms after School Clubs were sent out last week, so please check for when they start, the cost and how to apply for a place. Here is a quick summary:

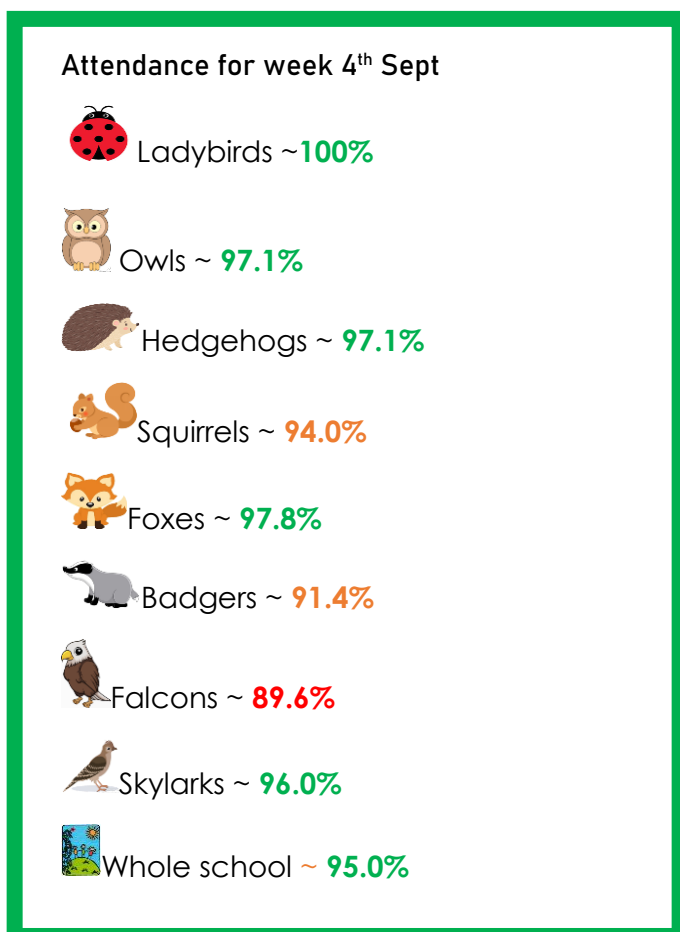
